This session offers a dive into integrating Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) into the Chinese language classroom, addressing the unique challenges of language instruction with strategies to marry emotional intelligence with language proficiency. Educators will learn about the five SEL core competencies, engage in collaborative and emotionally intelligent activities designed to boost language and emotional skills, and discover methods for incorporating SEL into existing curricula. By the end, participants will be prepared to create classrooms that nurture not just linguistic skills but also critical life competencies such as empathy and self-awareness.
